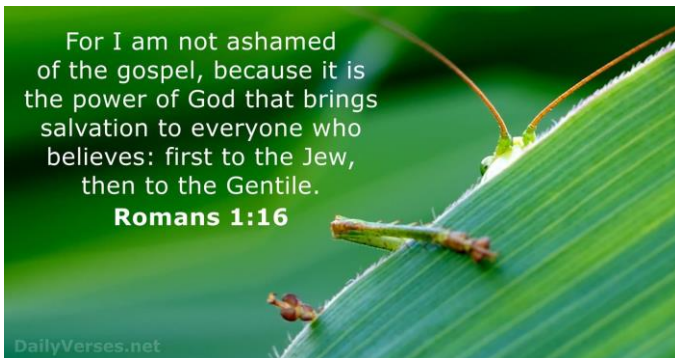

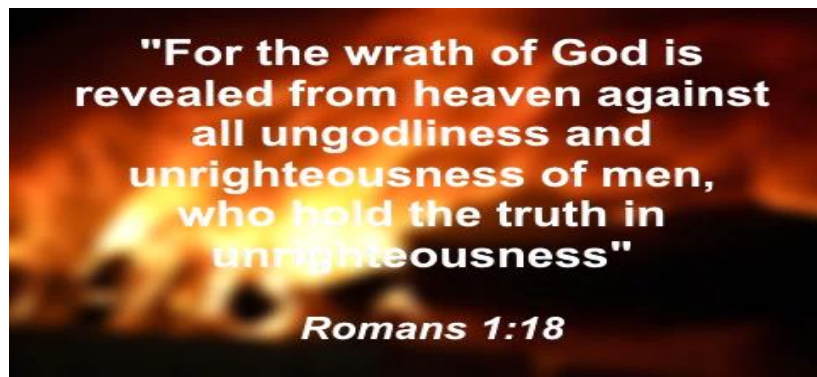

Questions to consider surrounding the text

Read Romans 1:18-20

1. Why is the wrath of God revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men?
2. Look at just verses 18 through 21 here. What is God making clear about the state of man and the reason for His wrath?
3. Sadly so many like to talk about how people are good but they overlook the fact that "all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23). If mankind truly knows about God and yet they continually spurn God's rules and commands, is anyone really good?
4. The truth is that no one does good, not one (Romans 3:12). There is a reason Jesus lets Nicodemus know that He didn't come to the world to condemn it, but to save it. Outside of an intervention from the Lord we are all condemned. This should cause us to look at our friends, our families, our co-workers, our neighbors, even our enemies and realize that outside of them coming to life in Christ; they are all condemned. Do you truly believe this is the case for those outside of the Lord's redemption? What would change your attitude and help you realize that you are commanded to go and point them all to Christ?
