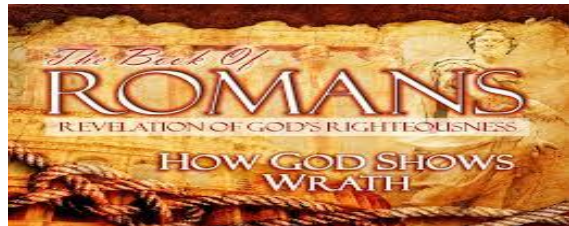

Questions to consider surrounding the text

Read Romans 1:24-25

1. Paul is talking about humans who reject the knowledge and worship of God. What does he say always happens to people who do this (verses 22-25)?
2. How does understanding the inconsistency caused by truth suppression help us to speak to nonbelievers about the Christian faith?
3. We are talking about idolatry here. When our focus – our worship, our service – is taken off of the Lord and put on anything – family, work, friends, money, etc. – we are exchanging the truth about God and worshipping and serving the creature rather than the Creator. Have you ever thought that this was idolatry – breaking the second commandment – and that God has let people over to this stuff because they don’t want to worship Him?
4. How, and how often, will you spend time simply giving glory and thanks to God for your life in his world this week?
