

Questions to consider surrounding the text

Read Romans 1:28-32

- 1. In verses 28-32, Paul emphasizes knowledge and an "unfit mind." How does an "unfit mind" lead to the behaviors listed in this passage?
- 2. What would it be like to live in a won where all the people were like those described in verses 28-32, especially those depicted in verse 32?
- 3. If we are honest with ourselves many small towns are like what we see described in verses 28-32. There is a reason many feel hurt by the things the community knows about them, and won't let them forget. Do you know those who have been hurt by gossip and slander in your own community? How can you bring them the Good News in the midst of that hurt?
- 4. How do we see the reality of God's present wrath in the world around us? Leviticus 26 might help, as well as Exodus 15:26.
- 5. Do you think your church community is less prone to this truth-suppression and idol-worship than the surrounding culture? Why do you think this?
