



Questions to consider surrounding the text

Main focus: Romans 2:6-11

Romans 2:1-11 has been building on itself so we will look at two of the same questions from last week.

- 1. Romans 2:1-11. You will notice that this whole chapter really has a main focus to it. An elevated pagan moralist, who agrees with Paul about the awful immorality of society and is appalled and shocked about the behavior of others, is the target of Paul's words in Romans 2:1-11. What is the chink in the armor of that moralist that Paul exposes?
- 2. What are examples in the news of people who support certain standards of behavior but don't even follow these themselves? (We have to be able to open our eyes to this reality in our own culture before we are able to bring the gospel to those around us because not only can we see this stuff in the news which tends to be quite easy but also seeing this stuff in our own lives and in the lives of those around us.)
- 3. Neither Greek nor Roman religion or philosophy had any doctrine of future judgment, but judgment was central to Judaism. Paul places his discussion of the final judgment in the context of this ancient pagan world. How would you summarize Paul's understanding of the final judgment in Romans 2:1-11?
- 4. What difference does truly finding rest, hope and honor in God alone make in someone's life, do you think?
