

In Genesis 2 we see for the first time God being referred to as Yahweh God, or Yahweh Elohim. I wanted to take a brief moment to talk about the name Yahweh.

We see this name in the Bible as LORD (all in uppercase). Why is this important? Names tell us and others who we are, who we belong to, and they ultimately define us. But no one can define God, no one can declare that God belongs to anyone or define Him. God simply is, and He alone can determine what we should think about Him or who we should relate to Him. When Moses asked God to reveal His true essence in Exodus 33, God replies in Exodus 34 with this revelation of Himself, beginning with the name Yahweh.

What is this name, Yahweh? Looking at Exodus 3:13-15, we see God use the phrase, "I AM who I AM." This is where some scholars say the name Yahweh comes from, with its meaning of I AM.

They say that the root is a form of the Hebrew verb, hayah, which means "to be." God is the "I AM", pure being. He is one who will be present, the one who is here, and the one who is always there. God is in every moment and every place.

The name Yahweh is repeated in Exodus 34 when God shows Moses his glory in order to add emphasis; thus, you have Yahweh, Yahweh God. God is declaring that He is the I AM, and that He as the I AM is truly God. He is the God who is true and faithful. By using this name, He shows how faithful He is, for He is the one who was, and is, and is to come. He is THE Promise Keeper. AND He is the One who runs the universe. God reveals Himself to Moses by declaring to Moses who He is, what He is like. But what is He like?

You can read Exodus 34:6-7 to find out. But here is the Reader's Digest version...full of grace and truth. You can also look at Psalm 145:8-9 and John 1:14 to see this as well.
