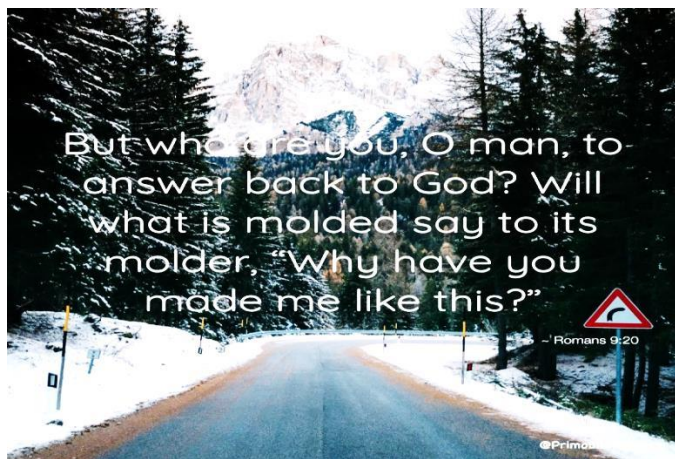

DID YOU KNOW?

Question: Is God unjust?

Granted that God's promise has not failed, but has been fulfilled in Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and in their spiritual lineage, is not 'God's purpose according to election' intrinsically unjust? To choose some for salvation and pass by others looks like a breach of elementary justice. Is it? ***What then shall we say? Is God unjust?*** Paul's immediate retort is ***Not at all!*** (14). He then goes on to explain. ***For he says to Moses, 'I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion'.*** Thus Paul's way of defending God's justice is to proclaim his mercy. It sounds like a complete *non sequitur*. But it is not. It simply indicates that the question itself is misconceived, because the basis for which God deals savingly with sinners is not justice but mercy. For salvation ***does not... depend on man's desire or effort***, that is, on anything we want or strive for, ***but on God's mercy.*** (16)
