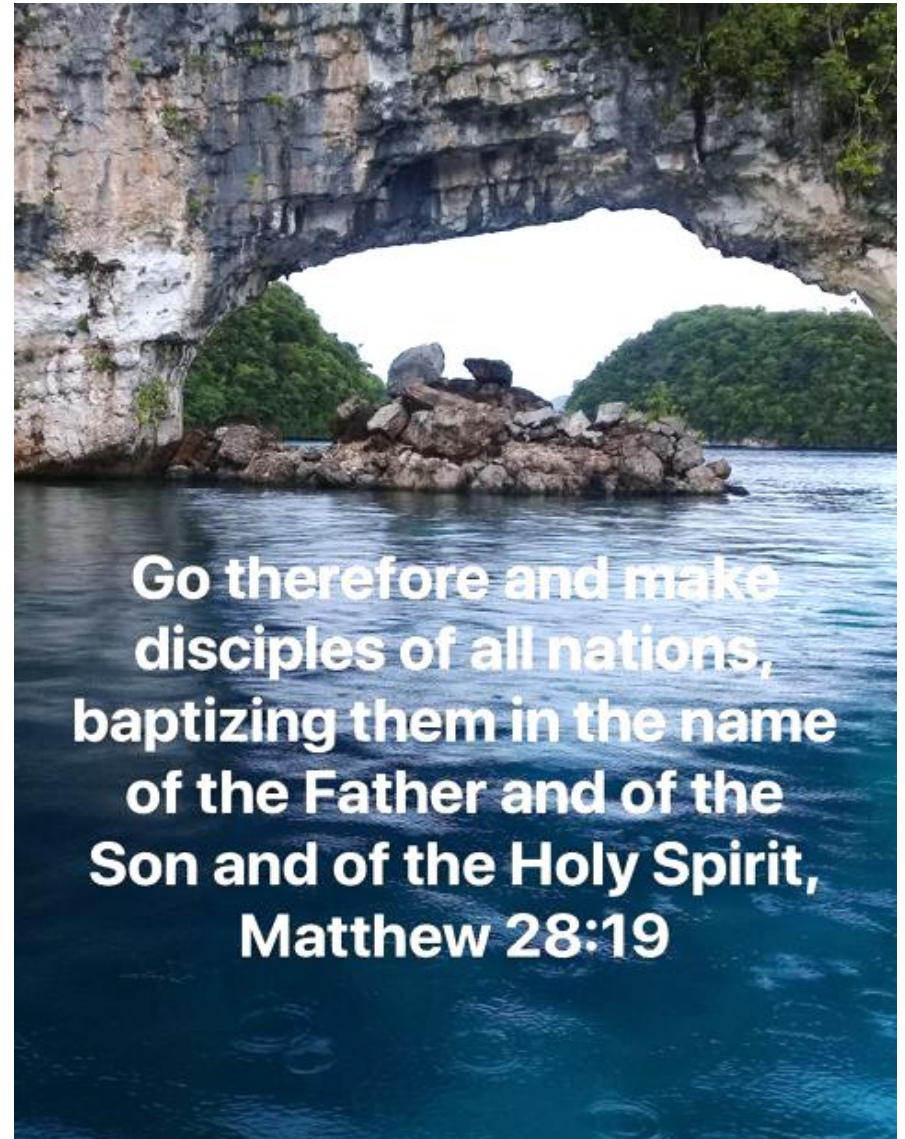

DID YOU KNOW?

The Great Commission

These words are for all Jesus' disciples, or course, not only for the apostles. They are for you if you have turned from your sin to trust Jesus Christ alone for your salvation and have become a disciple. If you have, then you are to work with other Christians to lead people to faith through the preaching and teaching of the gospel, bring them into fellowship of the church through the sacrament of baptism, and, within that fellowship, continue to teach them all that Jesus has commanded. What is wonderful about all this is that Jesus promised he will be with us as we do it. We witness in a hostile environment, but as we do, we know that Jesus will be with us to bless our efforts.

When we study the Great Commission, we notice that the word *all* occurs four time, though this is obscured in some version: (1) Jesus possesses *all* authority, (2) he sends us to *all* nations, (3) we are to teach people *all* he has commanded us, and (4) as we do, we are to know that Jesus will be with us *all* the days, or always...
