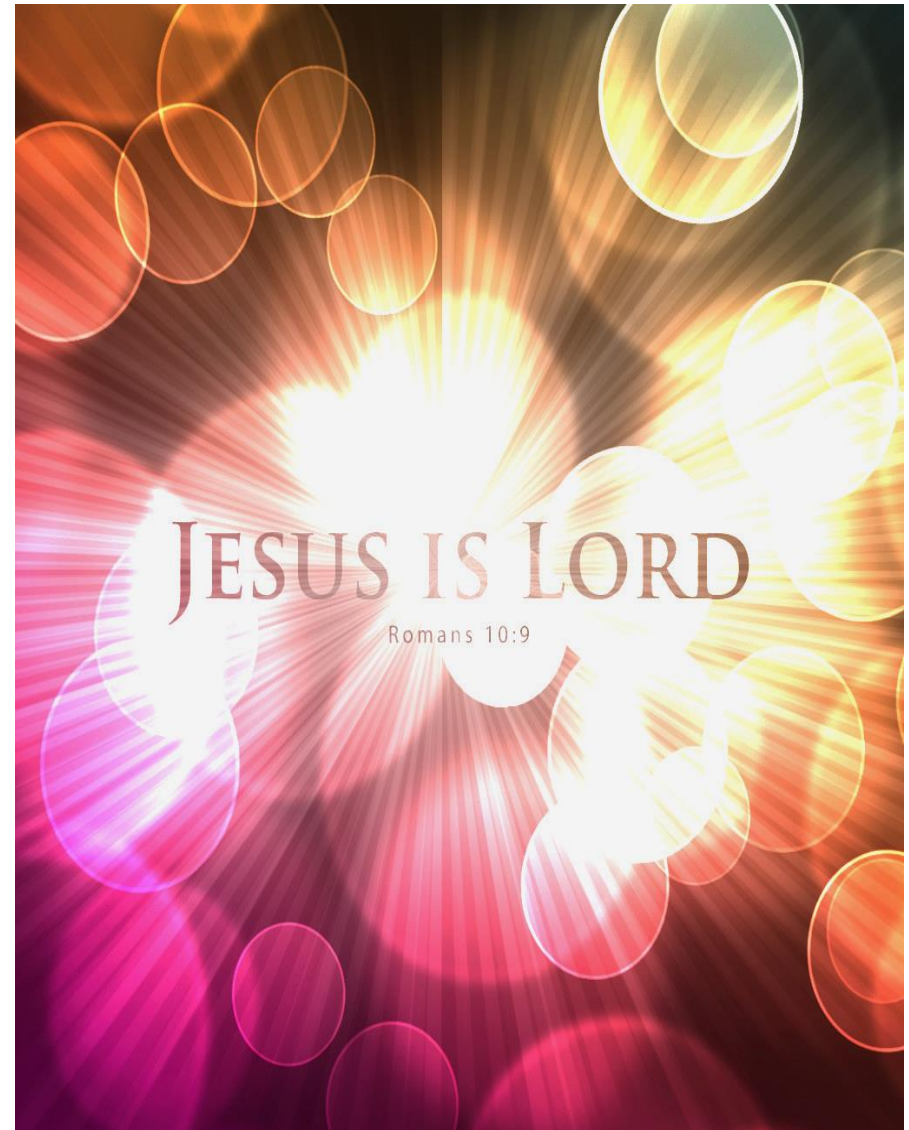

DID YOU KNOW?

Confess and Believe

“The Word is near you” (Romans 10:8) – but what is the “word of faith we are proclaiming, which (unlike the law) brings true righteousness? How does it save us? Verse 9 explains. First, this “word” is a truth that must be known. That content is seen as consisting of:

- (a) Jesus’ person. “Jesus is Lord” is a reference to all we know about Jesus’ divine identity. The Greek word Paul uses for “Lord” is kurios. In the Greek Old Testament, the word kurios was the translation for God’s personal name Yahweh. So to call Jesus kurios was not only to claim his deity, but to claim he was supreme authority over the world (the Caesars also claimed the title kurios or supreme ruler).
- (b) Jesus’ work. “God raised Him from the dead.” We must believe He was raised from the dead, and thus that He died. In other words, we must believe in Christ’s life, death, and resurrection for our sins.

There must be a basic body of content put before us. You cannot be saved by believing in believing! The hymn writer Horatius Bonar expressed it this way:

Upon a life I did not live,
upon a death I did not die.
Another’s life, another’s death,
On this I stake my whole eternity...
