Faith Works

“The combination of words and works, the verbal and the visual, is recognition that human beings often learn more through their eyes than through their ears. Words explain works, but works dramatize words. The public ministry of Jesus is the best example of this, and after His ascension into heaven He continued ‘to do and teach’ through His apostles (Acts 1:1). It would be wrong to conclude, however, that ‘works’ means only miracles. One of Jesus’ most powerful visual aids was to take a child into His arms, and one of the early churches was their common life and their care for the needy... Paul’s only other use of these three words [‘power’, ‘signs’ and ‘wonders’] is in relation to His ministry in 2nd Corinthians 12:12, where he calls them ‘the things that mark an apostle’... this is not to deny that God can perform miracles today... it is rather to acknowledge that their chief purpose was to authenticate the unique ministry of the apostles (see, Hebrews 2:4 for example).”
