

This is not their first time:

If you look at the first chapter of John's gospel you will quickly notice that Jesus meets the disciples before this account that we see in Matthew chapter 4. In fact, in

John chapter 1 verse 41, Andrew has already made the pronouncement to his brother Peter, "we have found the Messiah." It is here though in Matthew chapter 4 where Jesus calls these men to full time discipleship. Up until this point in Matthew chapter 4, these men had already made a commitment to Jesus, but they had not yet given their lives over to His leadership.

As we are walking through Mathew's gospel we are going to frequently see Jesus asking people to follow Him. This call to follow is so much more than just tagging along for the ride, at its core it means placing yourself in submission under His authority and living in obedience to Him as your King. We will slowly realize that every obligation that Jesus put on His first disciples – whom we see in Matthew – is the very obligation that Jesus is putting on us. We are already aware of this in some sense, for Jesus has commanded all of us to "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
