

# Scripture of the Month Matthew 5:11, 12

This is not their first time:

The theme of the Sermon on the Mount is the nature of the kingdom of heaven and the kind of life required of those who desire to become a

part of it. This is clear from the repetition of the words "kingdom of heaven" and from the way they are used. Reference to the kingdom is found in the first of the beatitudes ("Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven," Matt. 5:3); it closes the beatitudes ("Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" Matt. 5:10); it is given as a reason for the place of the Old Testament law in the kingdom ("Unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven." Matt. 5:20); it appears at the start of the Lord's Prayer ("Your kingdom come," Matt. 6:10); and it is the sermons climax ("Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven," Matt. 7:21). The Sermon on the Mount also follows Matthew's statement about Jesus preaching the "good news of the kingdom of heaven," throughout Galilee (Matt. 4:23-25), which clearly means He was teaching about the nature of the kingdom.
