"For where your treasure is, there your heart will also be"
(Matthew 6:21).

We must ask ourselves on a regular basis where our treasure is and likewise where our heart is. Where is that point of ultimate concern that grips our life? That is the diagnostic question Jesus is asking. He is saying to us, "Where is your heart? Where is your commitment? Is it to prestige or success or wealth, or is it to my kingdom?" He is asking whether He holds our heart. Our treasure lies in what we cherish.

Sproul gets right at the heart of the matter that Jesus is talking about. Jesus here with this statement is taking us back to the moral law where in the very first commandment the Lord says **"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the house of slavery. You shall have no other gods before me"** (Exodus 20:2,3). This commandment is at the heart of Jesus's comment on where your treasure is, there your heart will also be. Jesus in this statement is asking us to take an assessment on our lives. Matt Chandler phrases this assessment in a more tangible way by saying, "What does your checkbook show you in terms of what you are serving?"

So let's have a fun self-assessment this day, where would you say your treasures are being stored up? When we are looking to the Word – whether on a Sunday morning or during the week – we are being challenged to examine ourselves against the Word, and that leads us to repentance every time as Jesus is cleansing us by the washing of the water of His Word (Ephesians 5:26).
