Ask Seek, Knock

Ask and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be open.

To fully understand what Jesus is saying, we have to realize that

when we ask, we must ask aright. We must not ask for selfish reasons. We must not ask in an attitude that blasphemes the Holy Spirit. We must ask according to what God endorses in His Holy Word. He could have expanded that little aphorism to give a thousand qualifications, but He did not do that, because He is giving us a general truth. It is important that we realize that our Father is a God who loves to give to those who ask. As James wrote, "You do not have because you do not ask." (James 4:2) Jesus told this crowd that our Father knows what we need before we ask Him (Matt 6:32). So why now does He add this invitation for taking our requests before God? We do not improve God's knowledge by our prayers. Our prayers benefit us. Distorted Calvinists believe that since God ordains all things, we need not bother to pray at all, but that is an offense to biblical teaching. We are told in James's epistle that "the effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (James 4:2)
