

"power". It literally means "out of being" or "out of substance". Whenever Jesus spoke, His words were substantive. They were not trivial. They were binding on the consciences of all who heard. We cannot come into the church if we will not submit our lives to the authority of Jesus, because the Father has bestowed upon Him all authority in heaven and on earth. (Matthew 28:18).
