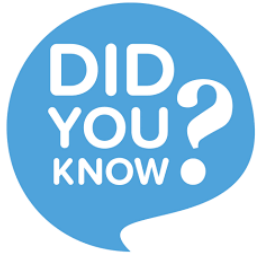

Scripture of the Month

Matthew 7:28-29

²⁸ And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine: ²⁹ For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

When Jesus opened His mouth and preached, He did not speak as one who had opinions. He spoke as one having authority. The Greek word translated as “authority” here is *exousia*. It also can be

translated as “power”. It literally means “out of being” or “out of substance”. Whenever Jesus spoke, His words were substantive. They were not trivial. They were binding on the consciences of all who heard. We cannot come into the church if we will not submit our lives to the authority of Jesus, because the Father has bestowed upon Him all authority in heaven and on earth. (Matthew 28:18).
