

The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few... Following Jesus' metaphor, we understand that one person could not go out into a huge field with multiple acres of grain and singlehandedly bring in

the harvest. Many laborers were needed.

Basically, Jesus was saying, "I am going to every town, every village, every synagogue, and I'm preaching, teaching, and healing everywhere I go, but you must pray that God will call other workers to join Me in this enterprise." It is not by accident that we find this text immediately before He called the Twelve and gave them their commission to participate in the harvest.

The message is simple: the kingdom of God needs men and women who will help to bring the harvest. Preachers, teachers, missionaries, and ordinary believers – all of us are called to participate in the harvest in one way or another. We cannot simply appoint ministers to do this job; they need a galvanized and equipped laity to assist them.


