Did You Know?

Divorce

The Pharisees come to test Jesus asking Him, “is it lawful to divorce one’s wife for any cause?”

Jesus responds by going to Genesis chapter 1 where we see the Lord Institute marriage and how when a man and a woman join together they become 1 flesh. As one flesh the Lord is clear, what God has joined together, human beings are not permitted to separate.

“Because Jesus based His answer on creation, many people and churches have come to the conclusion that the Bible makes no provisions for divorce whatsoever. I think those who take this position mean well and want to understand what Jesus had in view in the best light, but I think this is one of those cases where the text of Scripture is blatantly twisted to such a degree that it cannot be recognized. If Jesus had ceased to comment on marriage at that point, it would undoubtedly be true that He taught that there should be no divorce. However, He said more, and we dare not ignore what He said.” – R. C. Sproul

With Jesus’ answer, the Pharisees ask another question: “Why then did Moses command one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?” To which Jesus responded – because of the hardness of your hearts. We can harden our hearts in countless ways and in doing so we harm those around us. When we join in marriage we are making a covenant and part of that covenant is “for better or worse, through sickness and in health”.

Jesus here points out though that because of the hardness of your hearts it is better to give your spouse a certificate of divorce because you will end up harming your spouse more and more as you harden your heart towards God and your spouse. As we walk away from chapter 18 where Jesus has let us know that it is better to have a millstone tied around your neck and cast into the depths of the sea – showing judgment that is coming on you – than to cause one of the Lord’s children to sin, this permission that Moses granted the people was actually for the betterment of the spouse who is despised. When we start to see ourselves despise those who we are in covenant with, we need to fall on our knees praying to the Lord of the harvest that He softens our hearts.
