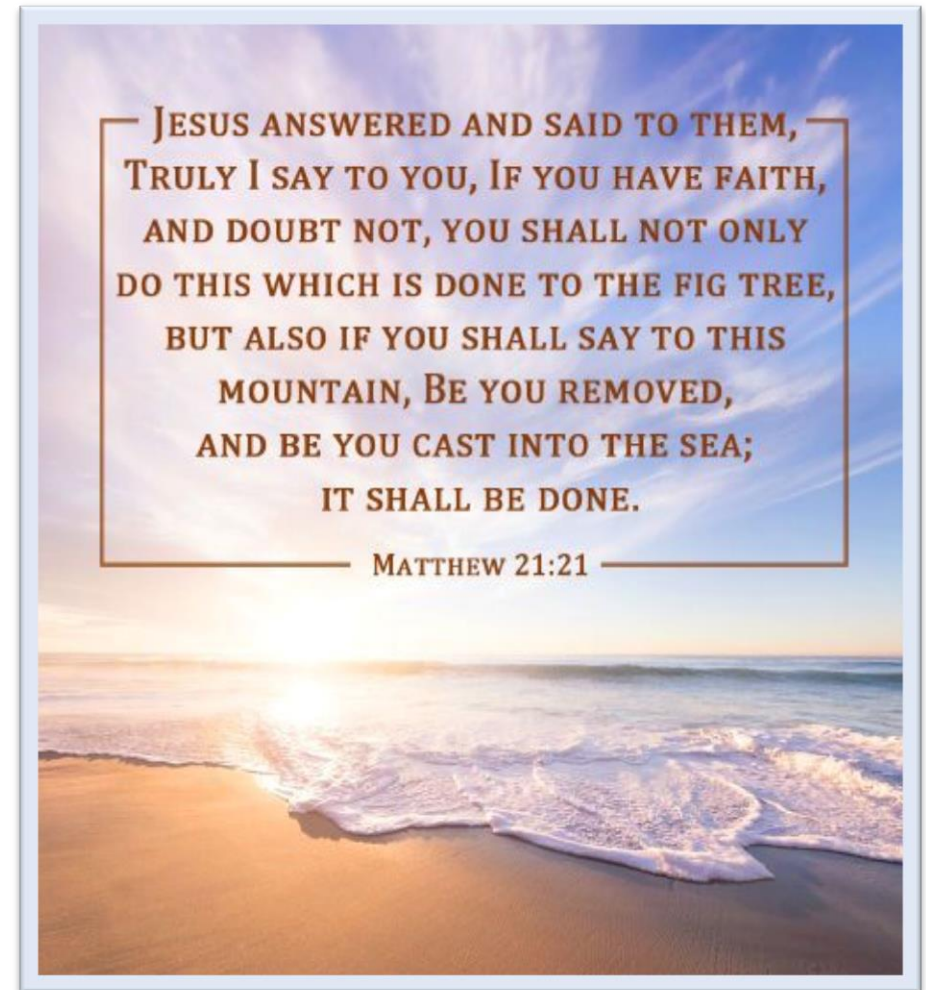

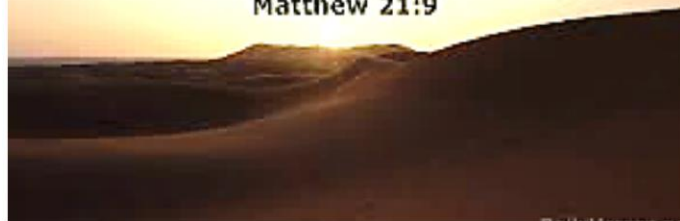

Did You Know?

Sproul penned in his commentary;

Jesus knew what was waiting for Him in Jerusalem. He was fully aware of the hostility of the Jewish religious leaders there. He also knew that the people who soon would be clamoring around Him and celebrating Him had a largely misguided understanding of who He was. They wanted a king in a chariot. They wanted a king who would drive out the Roman occupiers. They wanted a king that would set them free in worldly terms, not free from sin. In short, they were not primarily interested in a King who would bring salvation. Thus, it was doubly important in Jesus' eyes to fulfill the prophecies of old:

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey."

For Zion's sake I will not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a lamp that burns."
