



The final words of Sprouls commentary. A promise for you to hold onto:

Jesus did not end the Great Commission with this final admonition. Instead, He ended it with one of the most incredible promises He ever pronounced: “***And lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age***” (v. 20b). He assured the disciples that wherever they went to fulfill their mission, whatever borders they might cross—physical, cultural, racial, socioeconomic, and so forth—He would be with them. Though He returned to heaven, He remained with them, in a real sense. In regard to His human nature, Jesus is no longer present with us. He is in heaven at the right hand of God. But regarding His divine nature, which is perfectly united at every second to His human nature, He is never absent from us.


Knowing that Jesus is always with us, there should be no place on this globe we are afraid to go. If He were standing beside us and said, “Come; go with Me,” we would go wherever He led us. However, since we cannot see Him, we do not always live as if He is with us. But this is His promise. If He broke it, it would be the first one He ever broke, because Jesus does not know how to fail to keep His word. He is not merely present in our hearts, in our consciousness, or in our memories. He is really present. He is always with us.
